

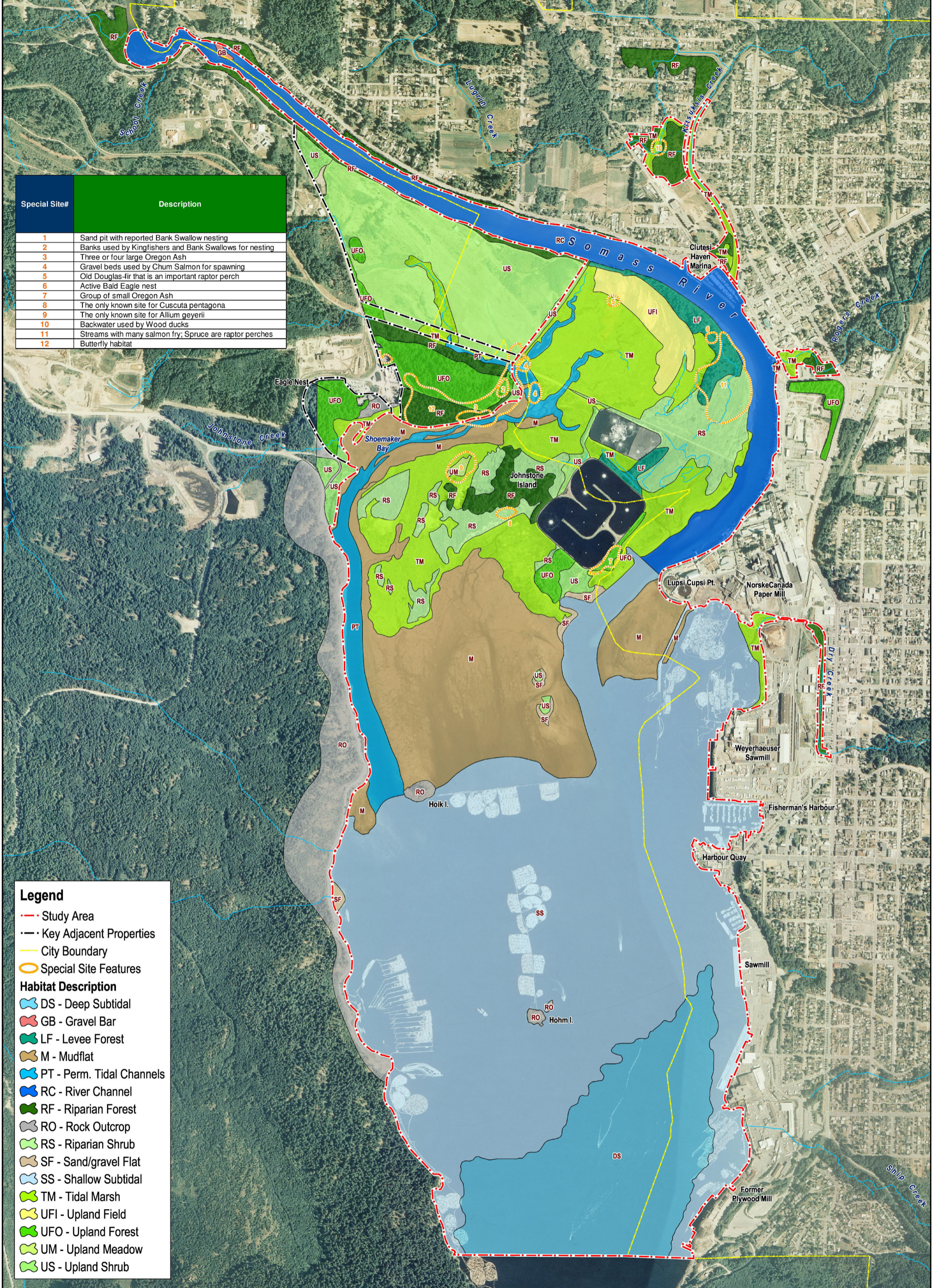

9	The only known site for <i>Allium geyerii</i>
10	Backwater used by Wood ducks
11	Streams with many salmon fry; Spruce are raptor perches

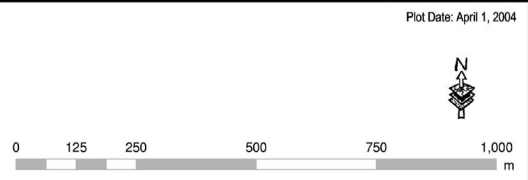
