



WATER RESTRICTION NOTICE

BEAVER CREEK WATER SERVICE AREA

Effective July 30th, 2012 UNTIL October 15th the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District is implementing water restrictions for all irrigation systems within the Beaver Creek Water Service area:

HOUSES WITH ODD NUMBERS can sprinkle between the hours of 8:01 PM – 9:59 AM ON ODD NUMBERED CALENDAR DAYS

HOUSES WITH EVEN NUMBERS can sprinkle between the hours of 8:01 PM – 9:59 AM ON EVEN NUMBERED CALENDAR DAYS



SPRINKLING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:00 AM AND 8:00 PM IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

Please note that hand watering of flower and vegetable gardens is permitted at anytime.

Thank you for your co-operation, please bear in mind the following points:

- Frequent watering promotes shallow root growth that in turn requires more frequent watering.
- Your lawn can become “addicted” to water. The more frequently you water it, the more it requires.
- Your lawn requires only 25mm (1 inch) every week. You can measure this with an empty tuna can.
- Watering during the heat of the day is wasteful as the significant majority of the water evaporates before soaking in.
- These restrictions help us to manage water quality, quantity and emergency needs.

Residents with automated irrigation systems should adjust the timing mechanisms of your systems to ensure compliance with these regulations.
