The 2016 Beaver Creek Watermain project will commence on August 10, 2016, between the hours of 7:00 am to 6:00 p.m. The 2016 Beaver Creek Watermain project requires upgrading to increase the size of the water main to supply better flow and pressure to the Beaver Creek Water System in the north end.

We are providing this information to the residents to allow for awareness of capital improvement work in your area. The plan is not to have an interruption in water service at this time. When tying in the new watermain interruptions are expected and notification at least two days prior to the planned interruptions will be delivered. When such work is undertaken there always is a possibility of an emergency water turnoff, these are unplanned and would be rectified as fast as possible to ensure service is continued.

The works will allow traffic to pass through the job site with alternating traffic when the install of the water main is occurring. Please expect minimal delays during this work. Flagging staff will be on site to direct pedestrian and vehicles. Road boulevards should be kept clear to provide access for equipment. The road and boulevards will be restored to the same or better condition at the end of the project.
