

Updates from the Bamfield Parks Commission subsequent to the April 20<sup>th</sup>, meeting

- Sink holes have been repaired and added gravel.
  - The shed for fire wood sales has been built.
  - The Float facility has been upgraded and maintained.
  - Seabeam Resort is donating the pig for the July 1<sup>st</sup> pig roast and the park provided peripherals. Seabeam wants the net to go to the park.
  - Both of the west side composters are emptied and running well and well used. Repair and maintenance happen year round.
  - The west side park has been well maintained and the old tether ball has been replaced with a shiny new one.
  - The community gardens are all in use and growing lots of food and flowers.
