Re: 2015/16 Capital Projects and Equipment

I am writing to advise you of the Island Health 2015/16 capital plan for which ACRHD cost-sharing is requested.

This request assumes ACRHD's usual annual funding amount of \$550,000.

Island Health proposes the following allocation which we have itemized in the attached project and equipment lists:

2015 ACRHD Allocation

Island Health will be completing its capital prioritization process in February and is requesting that the unallocated funding be reserved for additional projects and equipment that may result from that process.

Revisions to Prior Year Requests

Since Island Health's RHD request process last year, some larger high priority projects have emerged, some which are RHD specific, and some which are island-wide like the Unit Dose Medication Distribution System described below.

To fund these priorities, Island Health has had to defer and/or reduce the scope of previously approved RHD projects, which includes the following two West Coast General Hospital (WCGH) projects:

ACRHD will be advised on progress related to the WCGH Emergency Department triage area project. Planning is underway to revise the scope to address the highest priority areas. As this project is anticipated to be greater than \$1.5 million, a formal project request will be submitted requesting ACRHD funding approval. The project is currently planned to begin in 2018.

Unit Dose Medication Distribution System

As part of the Quality and Patient Safety Initiative, Island Health is implementing a strategy to implement a bar-coded unit dose medication system. This "closed loop" medication system uses a bar code scanning system to allow nursing and medical staff to verify that the right drug, in the right dose, and by the right route of administration, is being given to the right patient at the right time. Bar coding, when integrated with the advancement of the Island Health Electronic Health Record (IHealth) will serve as an automated independent double-check where none exists today. For 2015/16, Island Health is requesting cost-sharing to implement this project at WCGH. As the planning progresses, Island Health will provide additional information related to this project.

Tofino Helipad Project

As an update to my correspondence dated February 4, 2014, Island Health has reviewed the medium term option of using the Tofino Life Boat Station helipad located within a few minutes of the hospital. As Island Health was unable to secure stretcher access to the helipad through a neighbouring property, further review of the technical issues for this option has ceased. Island Health has met with the West Coast Committee as recently as December 11, 2014 to provide an update.

I would like to thank the ACRHD for its significant contribution to Island Health's capital projects and equipment. We are grateful for your support, and we appreciate partnering with you to meet Alberni-Clayoquot's health infrastructure needs.

Subject: 2015 Annual Budget

Recommendation:

That the Alberni Clayoquot Regional Hospital District Board of Directors give first reading to Bylaw 118, cited as "Alberni-Clayoquot Regional Hospital District 2015 Annual Budget No. 118".

Summary:

The Regional Hospital District paid for 40% of the West Coast General Hospital construction using long term debt secured through the Municipal Finance Assocation (MFA). The balance of the debt outstanding was approximately \$6.8 million at the end of 2014.

The tax requisition continues to fall as debt begins to expire for the West Coast General Hospital and the existing debt is reissued at lower interest rates. In an effort to avoid a negative spike in the tax requisition in the next couple of years staff investigated options for smoothing out the requisition including providing additional funds to Island Health (VIHA) for capital projects or making early payments on the outstanding debenture debt. Discussions with Chris Sullivan, VIHA Capital Planning Director, determined that an additional capital project is not an option this year as VIHA provides 60% of the funding and does not have the budget for any additional projects. Therefore, staff recommends budgeting \$300,000 of additional debenture debt principal funds as an early paydown of Municipal Finance Authority Issue #77 in the spring of 2016. Although this additional payment will not be made until next year, notification of our intention to make an early payment will need to be provided to MFA in advance of the adoption of the 2016 Annual Budget.

As in prior years, the annual budget includes an equipment grant of \$550,000 for Island Health to purchase equipment and complete projects for the hospitals in the Region. Island Health has provided a letter (also included in this agenda) explaining their capital plan for 2015. Staff recommends that we invite Chris Sullivan, Island Health's Capital Planning Director to a Board meeting to discuss capital projects in the ACRHD.

<u>Time Requirements – Staff & Elected Officials:</u>

There will be some time required of staff and elected officials to review the specific funding requests as they come in from Island Health.

Financial:

The requisition is 14.71% lower than that of the prior year. The residential tax rate has decreased from \$0.353 to \$0.294 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Policy or Legislation:

The Alberni-Clayoquot Regional Hospital District is required by Section 23 of the Hospital District Act to adopt an annual budget by March 31 of each year.
