




### Waste Disposal Comparison

#### West Coast Landfill









- \* Gypsum (1991)
- \* Land clearing waste (1992)
- \* Corrugated cardboard (1993)
- \* Recyclable Paper (1997)
- \* Scrap Metal (1997)
- \* Tires (1997)
- \* Commercial organic waste (2005)
- \* Garden waste (2007)
- \* Wood Waste (2007)
- Stewardship Materials (2007)
- \* Household Plastic Containers (2009)
- Metal Food & Beverage Containers (2009)

### 2007 SWMP – Disposal Bans

- \* Proposed bans on recyclable materials such as:
  - \* Cardboard
  - \* Paper
  - \* Metal
  - \* Yard Waste
  - Stewardship Program Materials
- Based on stability and capacity of local diversion infrastructure
- New diversion potential 15% or 3400 tonnes




### Current Regulations Alberni Valley

Bylaw R1006-5 Alberni Valley Tipping Fee Amendment,2013


- Garbage \$95 per tonne
- No charge for recyclable material
  - Paper, metal, boxboard, corrugated cardboard, compostable materials
  - \* Excludes any material contaminated by food or oil or a controlled waste
- Loads containing cardboard or controlled waste at \$130 per tonne

#### Process



### Work Plan (1)

#### 1. Diversion opportunities

- Assess/confirm diversion opportunities by material
- Review and update diversion quantities by material



#### 2. Collaboration (generators, haulers and processors)

- Provide input to regulations and enforcement protocols
- Provide input to education materials
- Provide feedback on enforcement

#### 3. Regulation

- Review current solid waste system costs and assess impact
- Review and amend current regulatory bylaws





### Work Plan (2)

#### 4. Education

- > Target based on results of collaboration
- Potential tools
  - Mailer to generators
  - Advertising
  - Media materials
  - Brochures/posters/flyers
  - Infraction Notices

#### 5. Enforcement

- > Review and amend current landfill operations contracts
- > Train operations contractor staff
- Phased approach





### Alberni Valley Haulers Feedback

#### Attendance 8+

\* 35,000 feet:



- Positive response many already providing service
- Markets are good/price fluctuates
- \* Ground Level:
  - Lack of information on recycling rate for large, medium and small generators



- City of Port Alberni commercial collection issues
- > Start with OCC MWP optional at first
- > ACRD needs to provide education support



#### Tofino Feedback

#### Attendance 20+

- \* 35,000 feet:
  - Overwhelming support "get on with it"
  - "Only a handful of businesses don't recycle OCC"
- \* Ground Level:
  - Lack of information on recycling rate for large, medium and small generators
  - Confusion over self-haul/depot options for small generators
  - Cost may be issue (\$0.30 per kg for ICI recyclables)





#### Ucluelet Feedback

Attendance: 8 (3 restaurants)

- \* 35,000 feet:
  - Limited support lack of space for container
  - Recycling costs \$300/tonne landfill costs \$95/tonne
- \* Ground Level:
  - Meetings should be in evening
  - Small generators need cost-effective collection and drop-off options
  - "When busy can't expect staff to be separating the waste streams"





## Program Design Issues

- \* Assess/confirm current level of recycling activity
  - Mini-Waste Composition Study "Dumpster Dive"
  - Drive by assessment/information from haulers
- \* Estimate impact on tipping fees
  - Will tipping fee need to increase due to decrease in revenue?
- \* Identify/provide cost-effective diversion opportunities
  - > Self-haul drop-off
  - Fees

  - Follow the leader approach
- Speaking engagements
  - ❖ Council, Chamber, ??
- Media ads/information
- Direct notice to generators



#### 2. Education

- > OCC Ban brochure
- ➢ OCC Recycling Guide
  - What services are available (collection/self-haul)

#### 3. Enforcement

- Pre-ban violation notices
- Inspection of loads
- Violation notices
- Work with hauler and generator to resolve



#### WC PMAC Feedback

- \* Support for OCC Ban
- \* "Devil's in the Details"
  - > Take time to assess/confirm current level of recycling activity
  - Walk-by assessment and mini-waste composition
  - Resolve self-haul drop-off issues
- \* Revise implementation schedule (two months)
- \* Communications plan required to build support




#### Vancouver Island Composting




### **ACRD Total Waste Disposal**




## Alberni Valley Waste Disposal

# RDN Waste Composition 2004



### ACRD Organic Resource


#### \* Alberni Valley

- $> 17,000 \times .40 = 6,800$  tonnes per year
- Includes yard waste, food waste, compostable paper
- Source ICI and Residential
- Assume 50% recovery = potential 3,400 tonnes per year
- Residential food waste only = 1,000 tonnes per year
- Landfill currently "processes" 568 tonnes of compost material

#### \* West Coast

- > 5,500 x .40 = 2,200 tonnes per year
- Assume 50% recovery = potential 1,100 tonnes per year
- Residential food waste only = 138 tonnes per year

# **Assessing Opportunities**



#### Reduction



- \* Avoid collection, avoid processing
  - Encourage and support backyard composting
  - Love Food, Hate Waste style campaign
  - Linking large generators to users (e.g. food banks)



#### Collection

- \* What to collect
  - \* Kitchen scraps
  - \* Yard waste
- \* How to collect
  - \* Separate or combined
  - \* Curbside
  - \* Depot
- \* Target Sectors
  - Single-family residential
  - \* Multi-family
  - \* Commercial/Industrial
  - \* Institutional





# Processing

- Create your own or used an established facility
- \* Technology
  - \* Low-tech/High-tech
- \* Ownership
  - \* Contract out
  - \* Own/operate
  - \* Partnership
- \* Location



#### **End Markets**

- \* Agriculture
- \* Erosion and sediment control
- \* Landscaping
- \* Reclamation
- \* Garden centres
- \* Topsoil Manufacturing
- \* Turf application
- \* Wholesale Nurseries



# Policy

- Used to support organics diversion objectives
- Mechanism to encourage participation in programs
- Encourages organic waste to be diverted to organics processing facilities
- \* Examples:
  - Ban commercial organic waste from landfills
  - Collection bans (enforced at curbside)
  - \* Yard waste and wood waste burning bans



# Organics Diversion Opportunities Assessment

- Assess and confirm organic waste quantities
  - \* By source (ICI & residential) and by type (yard, food, paper)
- 2. Review and assess local opportunities for reduction, collection, processing and markets
- 3. Review and assess supporting policies
- 4. Based on assessment of local opportunities refine reduction and diversion estimates
- Prepare high level cost estimates and cost/benefit analysis including impact on current system costs
- Prepare PowerPoint presentation outlining results and recommendations.

- \* 35,000 feet:
  - Great idea
  - We need compost
- \* Ground Level:
  - Sectors ICI only or include residential
  - Can OCC/paper be used in process
  - > Is there enough yard waste
  - Need to close the loop local markets





#### Ucluelet Feedback

Attendance: 8 (3 restaurants)

- \* 35,000 feet:
  - Large generator keen (Black Rock)
  - Small generators cautious
- \* Ground Level:
  - Need to build awareness of collection options
  - Must be cost-effective
  - "When busy can't expect staff to be separating the waste streams"
