a. Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Update

b. Raw Water Pressure – A. McGifford (Verbal)

Pressure from the raw water line has experienced issues recently. The contractor has identified possible causes. Staff will advise the water system engineer to provide possible solutions.

c. South Bamfield Road Fire Hydrants – A. McGifford (Verbal)

Project has been virtually completed as of the meeting date. Due to the depth of the water main, the project incurred additional costs to lower 4 of the 6 hydrants. The install costs are covered by the developer through the \$75,000.00 deposit.

d. Water Consumption – A. McGifford (Verbal)

Staff discussed trends and will provide options for a new rate structure with new operational costs associated with the water treatment plant. Consider increasing maximum threshold and reduced Bamfield Marine Science Center usage.
