VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS

GENERAL VOTING will be open to qualified electors of Electoral Area "F" (Cherry Creek) on **Saturday, April 6, 2019** between the hours of **8:00 am and 8:00 pm** at the **Cherry Creek Community Hall, 3720 Moore Road, Port Alberni, BC.**

ADVANCE VOTING will be available to qualified electors on **Wednesday, March 27, 2019** and **Tuesday, April 2, 2019** between the hours of **8:00 am and 8:00 pm** at the **Regional District Emergency Operations Centre Office, 3003 Fourth Avenue, Port Alberni, BC**

ELECTOR REGISTRATION & QUALIFICATIONS

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this by-election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in electoral area "F" (Cherry Creek) for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of the property owners.
