

Important Indicators

Who Is Dying?

69% Were Aged **30 to 59**
71.5% Were Men



Type Of Drug Involved

85.3% Fentanyl
46.9% Meth
40.2% Benzodiazepine



Method of Use

Inhalation **68%**



Health Authorities

All HA's Saw Increased Death Rates, except Fraser (2 Years Running)



Location

80% Inside

- **47%** Private Residence
- **28%** Hotel, SRO, Shelters Etc
- **5%** Other

19% Outside



Diversion - Regulated Safer Supply

Only 3% of deaths detected hydromorphone
