

COVID EOC (March 2020 – May 21, 2021)


Emergency Program staff supported several incidents:

- Cherry Creek Wildfire (Clayton Road) - June 2021
- Alaska Earthquake (8.1) – Tsunami Potential July 28/29
- High Streamflow Advisories – Sept/Oct
- Zim Kingston – Oct/Nov
- Flood Watch – Nov/Dec







- Spokesperson training




MOU with Alberni - District Fall Fair




