NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS FOR SCRUTINEERS EAST BAMFIELD SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM SERVICE ASSENT VOTING

On Saturday, November 16, 2024 an assent voting opportunity will be held within the East Bamfield Sewer Collection System service area on the following question:

Are you in favour of the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District adopting the following bylaws:

East Bamfield Sewer Collection System Service Establishment Bylaw No. E1065, which will permit the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District to establish and operate a sewer collection system in East Bamfield; and

East Bamfield Sewer Collection System Loan Authorization Bylaw No. F1163, which will permit the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District to borrow up to \$1,500,000 over a period not exceeding 20 years for the purpose of constructing a sewer collection system in East Bamfield?

Scrutineers for and against the question must be appointed if applications are received from persons who wish to volunteer for the positions. Only persons entitled to vote as electors in this assent voting opportunity are entitled to act as scrutineers.

If sufficient applications are received, one (1) scrutineer for and one (1) scrutineer against the question will be appointed for each voting place. One scrutineer for the question and one scrutineer against the question will also be appointed to be at the determination of the official results and, if necessary, at a judicial recount.
