



Voting Guide for First Nations in the 2022 General Local Election



Q I live in a First Nations community in the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District, who can I vote for in the upcoming General Local Election in October 2022?

A That depends! It depends on where you live and how many candidates are running for School District Trustee and Electoral Area Director.

Q Are you a citizen of the Huu-ay-aht First Nations or Uchucklesaht Tribe?

A You can vote for six School District Trustees in the Alberni Valley and Bamfield area.

Q Are you a member of the Ahousaht First Nation or Hesquiaht First Nation?

A You can vote for the Long Beach Electoral Area Director.

Q Are you a member of the Tla-o-qui-aht First Nation?

A If you reside in Esowista 3 or Opitsat 1 you can vote for the Long Beach Electoral Area Director. If you reside in the Tin Wis 11 please refer to the District of Tofino website for voting opportunities: <https://tofino.ca/your-government/municipal-elections/>

Q Are you a member of the Hupacasath First Nation?

A If you reside in the Ahahswinis Reserve you can vote for the Beaver Creek Director and six School District Trustees. If you reside in the Klehkoot Reserve you can vote for the Sproat Lake Director and six School District Trustees.

Q Are you a member of the Tseshaht First Nation?

A If you reside in the Tsahaheh Reserve, you can vote for the Sproat Lake Director and six School District Trustees. If you reside in the Alberni 2 Reserve, you can vote for the Cherry Creek Director and six School District Trustees.

Q Are you a member of the Ditidaht First Nation?

A If you reside on a Ditidaht Reserve in the ACRD, you can vote for six School District Trustees. If you reside outside of the ACRD, please refer to Cowichan Valley Regional District's website for voting opportunities: <https://www.cvrld.ca/988/Elections-Referenda>
