

Voting types/weights

Corporate Vote Unweighted (all directors; simple majority, e.g. 7 of 13)

- Appointment of officers and employees
- Resolution to terminate an employee with cause
- Procedure, bylaws and enforcement
- Establishing bylaws
- Amendment or repeal of establishing bylaws
- Bylaw to delegate public hearings
- Service review or service withdrawal
- Appointment of select committees
- Bylaw to establish local community
- General administration
- Electoral area administration
- Feasibility studies
- Giving consent for a service inside the RDKB, provided by another regional district
- Specific regulatory and other powers
- Election of chair and vice chair
- Decision to obtain approval by alternative approval process
- Financing municipal undertakings
- Approval of cost sharing for LGA Part 26 services (planning & land use management)
NOTE: municipal directors DO NOT vote if they've opted out of planning service.
- Agricultural Land Commission decisions
- BC Timber Sales referrals
- Crown grant applications

Corporate Vote Unweighted requiring 2/3rds consent

- Bylaw to delegate a power, duty or function
- Adopt certain bylaw at same meeting as 3rd reading (bylaws not requiring approval, consent or assent)
- Bylaw to provide property tax exemptions (including heritage properties and riparian properties)
- Repayment requirement in relation to heritage exemptions
- Resolution to terminate an employee without cause
- Emergency powers (emergency declaration bylaw)
- Resolution to obtain approval of electors overall, instead of obtaining approval separately in the participating areas
- Resolution to dispense with electoral area director consent

- Dispense with electoral area director consent for amendment or repeal of establishing bylaws
- Indemnification against proceedings

Corporate Vote Weighted (all directors; jurisdictional voting weights are counted)

- Acquisition, expropriation or disposal of property
- Authorizing person to enter into contracts
- Adoption of the financial plan
- Liabilities under agreements
- Bylaw to provide for revenue anticipation borrowing
- Bylaw for short term capital borrowing
- Loan authorization bylaws
- Security issuing bylaws
- Financing municipal undertakings
- Gas Tax Funds

You will notice that the above matters are financial in nature.

Stakeholder or Participants Weighted

- Administration and operation of service (except general administration)
- Authorities in relation to a service other than a regulatory service
- Grant-in-aid
- Reserve funds
- Bylaw to establish an annual variable tax rate system
- Development approval procedures
 - DPs
 - DVPs
 - TUPs
 - Floodplain exemptions
 - Zoning Bylaws
 - OCPs
 - Floodplain exemptions
- Bylaw to adopt a growth strategy for an area less than the entire regional district
- Heritage conservation bylaw and permit procedures (requires 2/3rds consent)

You will notice that the above matters relate, for the most part, to individual services.
