TIPPING FEE INCREASE

Why did the tipping fees go up?

Tipping fees increased due to rising operational costs in 2023 and to incentivize better waste diversion.

A study showed that a significant portion of self-hauled waste, including organics (39%), recyclables (34%), and construction/demolition waste (16%), is not being properly diverted.
