



IS YOUR WETSUIT READY TO RETIRE?

ReSurf is a program of Surfrider Foundation Canada, which keeps surf gear out of landfill through repair, reuse, material recovery and recycling. Canada-wide.

Based in Ucluelet, ReSurf has built a growing network of collection locations across Vancouver Island and British Columbia, creating a simple way for residents to manage old and damaged wetsuits responsibly.

WETSUITS ARE NOW BANNED FROM THE WEST COAST LANDFILL!

ReSurf has worked with the Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District (ACRD) to establish a landfill ban for wetsuits, helping ensure these difficult-to-manage materials are diverted from disposal. Please do not place old or damaged wetsuits in the garbage or bring them to the landfill for disposal.

Instead, bring your unwanted wetsuit to a participating ReSurf drop-off location, free of charge.

WHAT HAPPENS TO YOUR WETSUIT?

ReSurf assesses wetsuits and directs them toward the best circular pathway, extending their lifespan whenever possible through reuse and recovering materials when they can no longer be used through recycling and upcycling pathways.
