The following information is being provided for clarification and support for the preparation of submissions for RFP – SLFB02-26. This addendum will form part of the contract documents.

Please review the following information before submitting your response to RFP - SLFB02-26.

### Addendum 001 is being raised to answer the following questions:

*Q1: Is a hydraulic bow-gate system a mandatory requirement or would alternative actuation methods (ie. electric winch-operated) be considered acceptable?*

**A1: Alternate methods for bow-gate actuation that meet the operational requirements of the Fire Department will be considered.**

*Q2: Does the fire pump need to be self-priming?*

**A2: The fire pump needs to have a priming device.**

*Q3: Is there a specific make or model requirement for the emergency warning system including the siren and lights?*

**A3: No, there are no specific make or model requirements for the emergency warning system. The emergency warning system must satisfy the operational requirements of the Fire Department.**

*Q4: Are there any minimum performance specifications (brightness, color configuration, certification, etc.) required for the emergency light bar?*

**A4: No, there are no minimum performance specifications for the emergency light bar.**

*Q5: Is there a specific fire pump manufacturer or model that the ACRD prefers or requires?*

**A5: No, the ACRD does not have a preferred manufacturer or model for the fire pump. The fire pump must meet Fire Underwriters Survey requirements and the operational needs of the Fire Department.**

*Q6: Are there any additional performance requirements for the fire pump beyond the stated minimum pumping capacity of 1,050 GPM?*

**A6: No, there are no additional performance requirements for the fire pump.**

*Q7: Would equivalent fire pump systems from different manufacturers be considered acceptable provided they meet or exceed the specified performance requirements?*

**A7: Yes, fire pump systems from all manufacturers, that meet or exceed the specified performance requirements, will be considered.**
