Background:

The Alberni-Clayoquot Regional District is inviting proposals from qualified suppliers to supply a new 2000 Imperial Gallon, Water-Tender Fire Apparatus for the Sproat Lake Volunteer Fire Department. One unit is required as soon as possible, and a second identical unit will be required in 2024.

All proposals received will be date and time stamped. Proposals received after the date and time indicated above will not be considered. It is the responsibility of the submitter to ensure

their package is received prior to the closing whether sent by email, letter mail, courier or delivered in person.

The total proposed price shall be in effect for 45 days after the proposal submission deadline and shall include all applicable taxes and shipping costs to the Sproat Lake Volunteer Fire Department Hall #3.

Due to current COVID recommendations, proposals will not be opened in public. Proposal results will be forwarded to participants, if requested.
