Job Description

The Sproat Lake Marine Patrol employees will:

1. Provide information and advice to the public regarding:
 - a) Boating regulations;
 - b) Water safety;
 - c) Promotion of boating etiquette;
 - d) Navigational hazards;
 - e) Amenities and features of Sproat Lake and general tourist information.
2. Provide a presence at Sproat Lake to:
 - a) Observe and report dangerous watercraft operation;
 - b) Offer assistance that is compatible with the qualifications of the employee;
 - c) Observe on-shore activities.
 - d) Record and report activities or incidents of concern.
3. Develop and present a marine safety education info session for local K-12 classes.
4. Maintain patrol boat, other equipment and other facilities.
5. Content Creation:
 - a) Develop a social media campaign focused on Sproat Lake marine safety.
 - b) Incorporate professional social media best practices.
 - c) Maintain social network accounts including but not limited to: Instagram, Tik Tok, Twitter, and Facebook.
 - d) Create and publish relevant content on social media channels (photo, video, etc.) in alignment to marine safety campaign. Ensuring the content is informative and appealing.
 - e) Collaborate with local groups and businesses to create content on marine safety.
 - f) Present final report of recommendations/lessons learned from marine safety campaign to senior management and board.

Qualifications

The ideal candidates will:

1. Have the ability to deal effectively and tactfully with the public;
2. Have exceptional communication skills and be able to exercise sound judgment;
3. Have boat-handling skills; with confidence in trailering, launching and operating.
4. Must have a valid Pleasure Craft Operator Card;
5. Fluent in social media channels including but not limited to: Instagram, Tiktok, Twitter, and Facebook.
6. Ability to create informative and appealing social media content (Photo, video etc.)
7. Be familiar with Sproat Lake and the Alberni Valley;
8. Be enrolled in post-secondary education, returning to school in the Fall of 2022.
9. First Aid Training recommended.

Employment Conditions

The successful candidates will be required to be a member of CUPE Local 118 (Alberni-Clayoquot Unit). The pay is \$18.61 per hour including 16% in lieu of benefits. This is a temporary 35 hour per week position. The hours of work will include evenings and weekends. The employees will be based out of Sproat Lake Provincial Park.
