## Event Type: Heavy rain and possible wind over the next 24 hours.

A weather event is anticipated to impact the Mid-Vancouver Island Service Area. Rainfall totals could reach 100 to 150mm over the next 24 hours today through Wednesday. Strong, southerly winds are also expected over exposed coastal sections this morning. The area which will be most affected is the West Coast of Vancouver Island – Port Alberni, Ucluelet, Tofino and north from Tofino to Zeballos and Tahsis.

Localized flooding is possible, also rising freezing levels plus snowmelt may contribute to increased runoff. Mainroad crews will be patrolling for potential issues on all Service Area Highways and will be responding to reports from our 24-hour communications line.

Please slow down and move over for all roadside workers, drive with caution and before heading out check with [www.DriveBC.ca](http://www.DriveBC.ca) for road condition updates.
